Category:	Classroom Disruption
Behavior Types:	Calls out to teacher, Calls out to peers, Argues with teacher, Argues with peers, Scolds others, Teases others, Refuses to complete tasks, Talks too loud, Bosses others around, Throws tantrums, Uses bad language
Operational Definition:	Mr. Alexander is very disruptive. He argues with the teacher and peers and constantly disrupts class.
Frequency:	It usually occurs at least once and possibly several times a week. On average 4 time(s) for 10 minute(s).
Intensity:	Minor
Environments:	During class time, During transitions between classes, before school, or after school, Social / unstructured time, Lunch, 1:1 with adult, With peers, School bus (or other mode of transportation)
Setting Events:	Poor sleep, Hungry, After weekends, holidays, breaks in school, Following or during conflicts with peers, Following or during unexpected transitions or changes
Antecedents:	Presentation of academic tasks/demand, Presentation of social task/demand, Normal transition from one location to another, Unexpected transitions or changes, Being told to stop an activity before finished, Friendly attention from peers (could include inappropriate attention), Being denied access to a desired activity or object, Unfamiliar person in environment, Asked, directed, or encouraged to do something by a peer
Consequences:	Social reprimand given by adult
Goals:	Nothing entered
