About Rutherford County Schools

"To empower today's students to grasp tomorrow's opportunities."

Rutherford County Schools, located in the city of Murfreesboro, consistently ranks as one of the best school districts in Tennessee.

With a total of 49 schools, Rutherford County is one of the fastest growing school districts in Tennessee and the fourth largest behind those in Memphis, Nashville, and Knoxville.

The district strongly believes that all students should be empowered to reach their fullest potential.

The strategic plan

The Rutherford County Schools Strategic Plan was adopted by the Rutherford County Board of Education in December 2019. It was created under the leadership of Director of Schools, Bill Spurlock, who worked for months with the assistant superintendents to prioritize the district's greatest needs.

Some of the goals include developing a framework to address student equity, and training highly effective certified employees to support the district's growing and diverse student population.



Solving the disproportionality issue

Rutherford County Schools is comprised of 49 schools and has roughly 4,200 special education students. The district is currently building their own tier two database of strategies, but needed help with solving disproportionality challenges over the suspension of SPED students.

That prompted the district to divert some funding and find opportunities to support students with behavioral issues.

"To me, that's been a great opportunity, because it's allowed us to look at discipline as a whole, not just for that subgroup, and look at what are we doing to support students with behavioral issues, which of course feeds right into my primary role, which is supporting schools in RtI:B."

Looking to reduce suspension and expulsion rate district-wide

The district strongly believes in a consistent use of researched-based instructional practices to increase student achievement and growth.

Rutherford County leadership implemented Insights to Behavior to help reduce the suspension and expulsion rates for general and special education students district-wide. Behavior specialists are using the tool to collect and watch data, and to manage behavior plans for special education students. It is also used heavily at the tier two level.





A new opportunity

Prior to purchasing the tool, the district had a suggested bank of strategies for general education students, and several BCBS and behavior specialists that conducted their own FBAs and behavior plans for students with severe behavioral issues

Since the adoption of the platform in August 2019, Kenton Levings, the CEO of Insights to Behavior, has been working with behavior specialists to customize the tool to make it more effective for the district.

"I'm working with Kenton to really hone in on some specific, easier to implement strategies, that will become our database for the regular ed students at the tier two level. He has also been working with our behavior specialist on some ideas that they would like to see in terms of more options for data collection."

Implementing the solution

For Rutherford County Schools, the platform has played a vital role consolidating different levels of RtI:B implementation in schools. Insights to Behavior has helped the district streamline their processes and build much needed consistency.

The platform's highly customizable nature makes it easy to adopt and implement into the current processes in place at each school.

Behavior support specialists like Pamela Parker, whose job is to provide support and training to all the schools in the district, find the platform to be "a tremendous help in making sure that schools are implementing certain strategies consistently".

Since they started using the platform, behavior specialists have reported a significant increase in the amount of data being logged and readily available.

The ability to build customized and readable Behavior Intervention Plans has shown to be especially useful when a student transfers to another school or gets a new teacher. The new teacher can then easily access the strategies that have previously been used to support the student, and continue to provide the same support without interruption.

Drive adoption


Challenge: Determine how frequently the new process is adopted and used by teachers to create behavior intervention plans and conduct daily collect of student behavior data.

Change: Rutherford County Schools is now electronically collecting and assessing behavior data from a central interface with Insights to Behavior.

Outcome:

- Hundreds of daily frequency data points
- Thousands of duration data points
- Tens of thousands of data points on frequency by intervals.

Improvement: Each teacher is logging an average of six behaviors per day for each student with a Behavior Intervention plan.

Improve student behavior

Challenge: Reduce the frequency, intensity, or duration of maladaptive behaviors through implementing effective research-based interventions to foster positive replacement behaviors in the classroom.



 Changes and trends in student behaviors can be monitored over time.

Professional development


Challenge: Reduction in special education referrals for behavior-related reasons, addressing disproportionality, and social-emotional support skill-gaps.

Outcome: Through the District's adoption of Insights to Behavior every teacher has access to over 40 hours of virtual workshops to help learn effective classroom behavior management techniques.

Data:

- Workshops that have been accessed but not completed
- Workshops that have been completed

Improvement: Over a 60-day period district staff collectively certified attendance on completing over 1,000 training hours using Insights to Behavior workshops.





Building the tier two strategies database

While Insights to Behavior continuously supports the district by offering tier three and intensive behavior planning strategies, Rutherford County Schools discovered a need for more generic ones that can be used for tier two students. With the help of the Insights to Behavior team, Rutherford County Schools began developing a tier two database of strategies to support teachers who don't have a lot of experience with behavior planning.

After completing a bulk of training in November and December of 2019, Rutherford County Schools started using the platform consistently and saw a positive change in their behavior management system at both tier two and tier three levels.





