4. Hang up your backpack.



drink of water






Sometimes at school, I don't know the right answer to a question.







I feel embarrassed or I feel mad. I wish I knew the right answer.








It's okay not to know the right answer. I say, "I don't know." It is better to say I don't know instead of getting mad.






When I say, "I don't know" my teacher will help me get the right answer.











When I am in school, I raise my hand when I have a question.



Sometimes I forget and I shout out my answer.









This is rude to my friends and my teacher. If I have a question or want to answer my teacher, I raise my hand.

When the teacher asks a question, raise your hand quietly.






If the teacher calls on you, say the answer.
